Key Verses: Matthew 6:6-13

Talk Summary:

- Few people find prayer easy, but "prayer is our greatest weapon"
- Life is distracting and there are so many resources out there on prayer it can be confusing and overwhelming
- But Jesus is our example, how did he pray?

Keep it simple

- Matthew 6:6-13
- The lords prayer only takes about 30 seconds to pray
- it is short but it covers a lot and it is powerful. You don't need to pray a long time or use long words
- We see in Jesus ministry that he uses short prayers to pray for big things, healings, miracles, raising the dead

Keep it honest

- Psalm 139.23 and 2 Corinthians 10:5
- We all struggle to be honest
- But God already knows and he already loves us, there is no point trying to hide it from him

- Being honest with God helps us, it invites God into our inner life and as our thoughts are transformed our lives are changed
- Jesus was honest with God in the Garden of Gethsemane (Luke 22:41-44)

Keep it going

- 1 Thessalonians 5:16-17
- If we want to get good at anything then we need to keep it going consistently
- Keeping communication going, keeps any relationship strong and this is true with Jesus too
- Get rid of the mindset that says pray is at a fixed time and place but see it as a continuous conversation with Jesus
